- a. Multiple Ways to Get to Online Form:
 - i. www.smusd.us, under "Links"
 - ii. Within your email, on the top navigation bar, click "More"

II. What's New in PowerSchool

- a. Bookmark this website: http://smusd.powerschool.com/teachers
- b. Know your PowerSchool Login
 - i. If you don't know it, submit a request to District Office to reset your "PowerSchool Password"
- c. Attendance
 - i. Daily Attendance is the same as before,
 - 1. Click on the chair icon,
 - 2. Mark those that are absent or tardy.
 - 3. Remember to click "Submit".
 - 4. Do Lunch counts
- d. What's new?
 - 1. Language
 - 2. "Multi-day" feature is new BUT do NOT use.
 - 3. Seating Chart is new. YES, DO use.

- a. Part of Google "Apps", Google "Docs" is aka Google "Drive"
- b. Introduction: Google's version of Office in the "cloud"
 - i. word processing, spreadsheets, presentations, drawing.
- c. Everyone has access to it
 - i. http://docs.smusd.us.
 - ii. or login to your email, click "Docs" or "Drive" on top navigation.
