## When will I know my child's class assignjment?

Class assignments will be posted at your child's school at 4 pm the day before school starts.

To insure an educationally sound program, classes must be reasonably balanced in terms of class sizes, gender, exceptional and/or special needs, and ethnic origin. The best laid-plans for appropriate class balance can be turned upside-down with last minute student withdraw or enrollment. In late August, adjustments to class assignments are nearly always necessary. Therefore, for the educational benefit of all of the children, it is necessary to finalize class assignments close to the time school opens. We apologize for the inconvenience in advance, and ask parents to be patient and anticipate alternate plans for child-care needs.

#### What happens if the kindergartens at the school of residence are full?

Assignment to the school of residence is made on the basis of order of enrollment in the district. When kindergartens at a child's school of residence are full, the Registrar must assign the child to the school with space. Under San Marino Board Policy, this child is returned to his/her school of residence in the fall of the following school year.

#### How are children assigned to classes?

Assigning a child to a class is made in the context of what is best for each child and for the group as a whole. All of the following factors are taken into consideration by the principal. These factors are not considered in the order that they are listed below, and, with the exception of a federally mandated program described in an existing IEP or Section 504 Plan, the decisions are not made based on one factor alone.

- □ Mandates of a child's Individual Education Plan (IEP) and/or Section 504 Plan
- Reasonable balance of children in consideration of educational needs, gender, twins/triplets, and ethnic origin.
- Delayed enrollment or retention in kindergarten
- Family circumstances of extreme hardship
- □ Birth-date
- Order of enrollment

## What factors may not be considered during placement?

The following circumstances are understandable reasons on which parents base their preferences, but because they are the same for nearly everyone, it is not appropriate to use them as criteria for placement decisions.

- Positive history with a particular teacher
- Participation in school related activities
- Parents' work schedules
- Child care schedules

## How will my twins/triplets be assigned?

Unless the parent submits a <u>written request</u> for an alternate course of action <u>prior</u> to class assignment, all of the children from one family who are in the same grade level will be assigned to a different teacher.
